

Rosser Transfer Station Information

Resident / Ratepayers_– may use all *designated areas* of recycling, household waste, composting, brush and small amounts of clean lumber, tires, scrap metal, used oil and electronic recycling.

Non-resident / Non-ratepayers – may not use household waste bins (you may be asked to provide proof that you are a resident or ratepayer from the RM of Rosser.

WHAT WE DO RECYCLE:

- Glass or glass jars - liquor and wine bottles, food jars.
- Aluminum food, beverage or tin cans - steel (tin) food cans.
- Newspaper - inserts flyers and junk mail, magazines, phone books, household paper, shredded paper and envelopes.
- Plastics (with the recycle numbers 1, 2, 5, 6 ,7 printed on them).
- Corrugated Cardboard (flattened) and boxboard- cardboard egg cartons and paper tubes, milk and juice cartons, juice boxes, pizza boxes, cereal boxes, etc.
- Used oil, antifreeze (Residential only) – storage container on site.
- Scrap Metal – Container on site.
- Tires - Tire drop off area.
- Compost Material - designated compost material drop off area.
- Batteries - in green container on hill, marked with sign.
- Propane Tanks - in green container on hill, marked with sign.
- Used oil, anti-freeze, windshield washer fluid.
- Anti-freeze containers – Storage bag on site.
- Used oil filters – Drum on site.
- Paint Cans - go in green container on hill, marked with sign.
- Household Chemicals – go in green container on hill, marked with sign.
- Electronics - designated drop off area (See attached electronics recycling eligible list).
- Cellphones - box in green container on hill, (Door with batteries and propane marked on it).
- Ink Cartridges/laser cartridges - box in green container on hill, (Door with batteries and propane marked on it).
- Light Bulbs - we accept CFL and fluorescent lights at our landfill.

* See landfill attendant for proper disposal

WHAT WE COLLECT FOR DISPOSAL: (Do not put in recycle bin)

- Household hazardous waste containers such as:
- Antifreeze
- Motor oil, windshield washer fluid, bleach, pesticide or herbicide. Many hazardous waste products can be identified by the danger symbols such as corrosive, explosive, poison and flammable). We have areas at our transfer station for these items.
- Aluminum foil, foil pie plates, wrapping paper with foil
- Cellophane
- Food containers made of foil or foam or frozen wrappers
- No plastic bags
- No foam packaging, foam egg cartons or foam meat trays
- Dishes, crystal or ceramics
- Food waste
- Napkins, paper towels or tissues
- Plastic furniture
- Textiles
- Toys
- VHS or cassette tapes or CD's
- Wax or foil coated paper
- Window glass, mirrors or any other broken glass
- Steel pots and pans or any other scrap metal (We have a designated bin for steel and scrap metal)
- Bio-based or compostable bags
- Regular garbage bags (plastic)
- Plastic Grocery bags (you can return them to some grocery retailers, or put in household trash)

Other Items Not Accepted:

Appliances with compressors such as fridges and freezers, air conditioners, water coolers or portable fridges.
